

# APGA Outstanding Contribution to the Australian Pipeline Industry Award 2026

The Outstanding Contribution to the Australian Pipeline Industry Award, initiated in 1995, recognises individuals making significant and sustained impacts across the pipeline industry, irrespective of their company affiliation.

Eligible nominees, including current and former members (excluding current Board members), are nominated by appointed representatives of current Full Members or Individual members.

Nominees are evaluated based on the following criteria:

Notable contribution to the entire pipeline industry or a specific sector. Recognition of the nominee's contribution as valuable by the industry. Sustained contribution over numerous years.

Demonstration of effective leadership for the industry.

The APGA Board of Directors assesses nominations and selects the award recipient, to be announced and presented during the APGA Convention on September 7, 2026, at the Darwin Convention Centre.

Nominations close on 30 June 2026. Accompanying the nomination form, a brief nominee biography and an outline addressing the specified criteria must be included. Visual aids, such as images, supporting the entry are encouraged for potential use in APGA publications and external media outlets.

For nominations to be considered, they must specifically address the outlined criteria provided above, emphasising notable contributions, industry recognition, sustained commitment, and leadership within the pipeline industry.

Nominations for the 2025 Award must be **submitted online by 30 June 2026**.
